Kindly confirm if the new proposed review and policy would enable a business like ours that owns the business name Berrima Accommodation to also register the domain berrimaaccommodation.com.au and thus prevent companies like Acheeva stock piling for profit.

Kindly review all domains under control of Greg Brown and Acheeva to identify such abuse of the intended policies if I understand them correctly.
