I like to comment and make some suggestion on the eligibility for .au domain names.

1) For business domains ending in com.au or net.au the current rules are OK but Australian citizenship (not permanent residents) of the owner (sole trader) or the director (company) should also be mandated. The same should applies to org.au and asn.au for organisations and associations

2) Currently private Australian citizen can register a domain name ending in .id.au but they have to use their first name, family name, or nickname (abbreviation, combination, etc..) This could compromise their privacy. I suggest that the rules for .id.au be changed to be the same as .au where any name can be used in front of .au Eligibility should also be restricted to Australian citizen be they a private person or a business director.
