Hello .auDA,

I'm commenting further regarding the "ideas" that the panel are looking now to put in place.

Regarding Section 5.3(1) in the Policy Advisory Panel Draft Report, I had at the time thought in my submission that domain reselling was classified as domain monetisation due to people making money off these domains.

Now in the Rules Review Draft Report, Recommendation 2, I am quite receptive to suggestion 2 and 3, however I believe there will be some issues with number 3 if it's implemented.

E.g

- People who hold these domains for purposes not to profit from it and just to create random mini projects will be affected
- Small businesses would be affected and would choose easier TLD's like .com and .io
- And if someone creates an app eg xyz.com.au but their business name is Optus (no specific reason) then they'd have to register business names trademarks etc just for one domain that you've proved to be affordable

One more thing, with Recommendation 4 I believe they should keep it unlisted and publish the statistics because auDA has made a great point that bad actors would use it to scoot around detection for longer.
