

Dear Review Committee,

I'm concerned about the current method for resolving .au TLD disputes. I'm up against a party that keeps re-registering [REDACTED]*.com.au to contest the domain name [REDACTED]*.au. I first registered [REDACTED]*.id.au in June 2004.
