### **Our compliance priorities**

This year, we are focused on uplifting compliance in several key areas to enhance trust, support greater transparency and accountability, and preserve the integrity of the .au domain for Australians.

#### **WE SEEK TO ENSURE:**

- Only genuine not-for-profit and charity organisations hold org.au domain name licences by conducting audits of licences in the org.au namespace
- Registrars maintain accurate records of the legal entities responsible for domain names registered on behalf of trusts and unincorporated bodies by conducting audits of registrars' record keeping processes
- Registrars meet their compliance obligations under the .au Licencing Framework by providing tailored training, resources and direct support to them
- Registrars undertake complete and accurate validation of a registrant's eligibility every time a licence is registered, transferred or renewed by providing tools and training materials to registrars and conducting audits of their validation processes
- Foreign companies using an Australian trade mark to meet the local presence requirement comply with the exact match requirement by conducting audits of domain name licences in the com.au and net.au namespaces

Our compliance priorities have been identified through a variety of mechanisms including analysis of complaints data, and audits of registry data and registrar processes.

## **Measuring success**

We will measure performance against our Compliance Plan through targeted audits, registry and registrar data and direct feedback from registrars.

We will report publicly on our compliance priorities annually.
