It is part of Australia's critical infrastructure, and we have been endorsed by the Commonwealth Government to ensure it is a secure, accessible and trusted Australian public asset for all internet users. auDA represents Australia's interests internationally and has an agreement with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN).
