Dear Mr. Whitehead:

We have read with interest the draft recommendation of the auDA New Names Advisory Panel of February. We are disappointed with the report's conclusions with respect to closed 2LDs in general, and the lack of recommendation of the catholic.au proposal in particular.

We note that the panel found the catholic.au proposal to be "well documented and strongly argued, with a great deal of supporting information" and that it "rates well against the selection criteria." That the panel retains the view that the Catholic community in Australia is a "single organisation" does not recognise the complexity and distinct terms of auspice of Catholic entities as diverse as aged and childcare services, parishes, hospitals, schools, retreat houses, religious community residences, welfare services, hostels, universities, etc., which collectively make up the Catholic Church in Australia

On its merits, we believe a positive recommendation for our proposal is justified. Our submission has met, and in many instances exceeded, the standards that were set forth in this process. Furthermore, we believe the proposal is consistent with the spirit of creating an Australian domain name space that responds to the needs of Australian communities

We hope the draft recommendations will receive further reflection in this regard. We again reiterate our willingness to work with the New Names Advisor Panel and the auDA Board in this process.
