RSD 23.4 Domain Watchlist	<p>(a) The Registry Operator must implement the functionality to monitor, on behalf of auDA, for the registration of domain names that match a list provided by auDA.</p> <p>(b) The Domain Watchlist must support wildcards.</p>	<p>Can auDA please provide a sense of how many such wildcard values they expect to have?</p> <p>Order of 10/100/1000'S?</p>	<p>auDA is typically looking for domain names that contain a keyword like ANZAC. So the wildcard entry would be *ANZAC* - so that we can detect the keyword at the beginning, middle or end of a domain name. The current number of keywords (and therefore wildcards) is currently less than 100.</p>
